

CREATING AN EXECUTIVE-LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE FOR BOUNDARY DISPUTES AMONG BARANGAYS IN QUEZON CITY

WHEREAS, some Quezon City barangays have outstanding boundary disputes with one another. In this regard, Section 118 (a) of Republic Act No. 7160, the Local Government Code, provides that boundary disputes involving two or more barangays in the same city shall be referred for settlement to the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* concerned;

WHEREAS, to aid the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* in its settlement efforts, it would be helpful for a committee composed of the appropriate city government offices to review the concerned disputes and recommend the appropriate solutions;

WHEREAS, to guarantee the smooth and effective performance of their functions, the barangay leaders must be cognizant of their respective territorial jurisdictions. Thus, it is imperative and beneficial to settle all disputes over the territorial boundaries in order that barangay leaders may be discharge their duties decisively and efficaciously.

NOW THEREFORE, I, MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, Mayor of Quezon City, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:


