PROPOSED ORDINANCE, S-2025

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A CERTIFICATE OF RECOGNITION, AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (100,000.00Php) TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF QUEZON CITY POLICE DISTRICT (QCPD) PERSONNEL WHO DIED IN THE LINE OF DUTY.

INTRODUCED BY COUNCILORS DON S. DE LON and TATAY RANNIE LUDOVICA

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to promote and protect the general welfare of its inhabitants, specifically by enacting legislative measures;

WHEREAS, our City recognizes the vital role played by our uniformed men and women assigned at the Quezon City Police District, whose life and limb are often put at risk, being the front liners in the maintenance of peace and order;

WHEREAS, such additional incentive will further ensure the faithful discharge of their constitutionally sanctioned function to protect the safety and security of the residents of this City;

WHEREAS, the unfortunate and sudden demise of our police personnel while in the line of duty often results in a huge financial dent on the part of the family left behind by said police force;

WHEREAS, due recognition should be given to our fallen police personnel who put their own safety at risk, in order to enforce the law and protect the lives of the constituents of this City

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

- **Section 1. SHORT TITLE -** This Ordinance shall be known as the "Certificate of Recognition and P100,000.00 Financial Assistance for QCPD personnel who died in the line of duty."
- **Section 2. COVERAGE** All police personnel assigned at the QCPD who have died in the line of duty.
- Section 3. APPROPRIATION The funds necessary for the grant of financial assistance in the amount of 100,000.00 pesos shall be taken from the budget of the Social Services and Development Department (SSDD).
- Section 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders, rules and regulations, or any part thereof inconsistent herewith are deemed repealed, modified or amended accordingly.
- Section 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. In case any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after the publication requirements have been complied with.
