AMORANTO CORNER CORDILLERA STREET, BARANGAY MAHARLIKA, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR)

WHEREAS, RAC Phil Corp. is a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine laws, with business address at Unit 2, City Square Building, N.S. Amoranto corner Cordillera Street, Barangay Maharlika, District I, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the applicant was previously granted a Special Permit by the Quezon City Council for the operation of the same Electronic Specialty Games establishment through Resolution No. SP-8820, S-2021;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to continue its business operations, there is a need to renew its Special Permit pursuant to an existing city ordinance;

WHEREAS, the operation of Electronic Games (E-Games) is regulated and licensed by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR);

WHEREAS, the aforementioned business activity will provide employment and additional revenue to the City Government;

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended and Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, authorizes the City Council to grant or renew a Special Permit to business activities of the same nature.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of Pot of Gold Internet Gaming, Inc., for the operation of Electronic Games (E-Games) located at Unit 2, City Square Building, N.S. Amoranto, Barangay Maharlika, District I, Quezon City, subject to the Rules and Regulations Promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the authority to operate an Electronic Games (E-Games) granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. The holding of E-Games shall be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;
2. The operation of E-Games shall not include playing of games not related to or other than E-Games;
3. The operation is enjoined to prohibit from playing in the abovementioned games in their gaming site individuals below twenty-one (21) years of age or students of any school, college or university;
4. Pot of Gold Internet Gaming, Inc. shall remit to the City Treasurer a license fee of three percent (3%) of the gross receipt of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasurer's Office during the lifetime of this Resolution, in accordance with

Section 25 of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2779, S-2018, as amended; and

5. This Resolution is non-assignable, non-transferrable and site-address specific.
6. The establishment shall not be a nuisance to public safety and order.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that this renewal of a Special Permit to operate an Electronic Games (E-Games) shall be valid for a period of three (3) years from the approval of this Resolution and may be renewed by the City Council.



RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the authority to operate an Electronic Bingo Games and other related gaming activities granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions:


- a) The holding of Electronic Games shall be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;

- c) The operator is enjoined to prohibit individuals below eighteen (18) years of age from playing in the above-mentioned games.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that this renewal of Special Permit to operate an Electronic Bingo Games shall be valid for a period of two (2) years from the approval of this Resolution and may be renewed again by the City Council.

6. Establishment shall not allow persons under twenty one (21) years of age or students of any school, college or university to play in their gaming site;
7. Establishment shall not be a nuisance to public safety and order;
8. Establishment complies with all clearances, documentary requirements and other applicable local ordinances and national laws.

The City Government reserves the right to immediately close all gambling establishments which are operating without a special permit, business permit, and/or license from PAGCOR, those which are operating games of chance other than those for which the special permit was issued and for any violation of this Resolution.





