AN ORDINANCE AMENDING QUEZON CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-3261, S-2024 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE FELLOWSHIP TRAINING PROGRAM OF GERIATRIC MEDICINE, A SUB SPECIALTY OF INTERNAL MEDICINE DEPARTMENT OF QUEZON CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL, CREATING PLANTILLA POSITIONS, ALLOCATING FUNDS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"

*WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3261, S-2024 was enacted to establish plantilla positions for the Geriatric Medicine Training Program of Quezon City General Hospital (QCGH) to provide comprehensive geriatric assessment and management and other services to the senior citizens of Quezon City;*

*WHEREAS, after further review and assessment, adjustments are necessary in the said plantilla positions to optimize the staffing and resource allocation for the Geriatric Medicine Training Program of QCGH.*

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3261, S-2024 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE PROGRAM. – The Fellowship Training Program of Geriatric Medicine Department of Quezon City General Hospital (QCGH) is hereby created and established in QCGH to oversee, streamline, and centralize the assessment, care, and management of out-patient and admitted senior citizens of Quezon City.”

SECTION 2. Section 5 of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3261, S-2024 is hereby amended to reflect the following changes for the Geriatric Medicine Training Program of Quezon City General Hospital (QCGH):

1. Adjustment of the number of Medical Specialist II (Part-Time) positions from four (4) to one (1) position;
2. Rectification of the salary grade (SG) of Medical Specialist III from SG-25 to SG-24;
3. Rectification of the qualification standards on education, experience, and training for Medical Specialist III and Medical Specialist II positions.

SECTION 3. The said plantilla positions in the Geriatric Medicine Training Program of QCGH are hereby revised as follows:

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect. 7
