ORDINANCE NO. SP- 3443, S-2025

*AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AND REGULATING THE VARIOUS STREETS IN BARANGAY NOVALICHES PROPER, DISTRICT V, QUEZON CITY AS ONE-SIDE PARKING AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF*

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*WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Novaliches Proper has passed Barangay Ordinance No. 04, S-2024, entitled "An ordinance declaring, designating and regulating the various barangay streets in Barangay Novaliches Proper, District V, Quezon City, National Capital Region as one (1) side parking areas for the vehicle owners thereat, providing penalties for violation thereof";*

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WHEREAS, the improper parking of vehicles on undesignated areas creates enmity among the neighborhood in the community and clogging of streets of stalled indiscriminate parking on both sides of the streets;

WHEREAS, Section 3 of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-867, S-2000 stated that the designation and implementation of the one-lane parking scheme is left to the discretion of the barangay concerned:

WHEREAS, Section 458(a)(5)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides for the powers, duties, functions of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, such as:

“(vi) regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon and, when necessary, in the interest of public welfare. xxx”

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the same Code states that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare of the inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Sections 5(e) and (f) of Republic Act No. 7924 creating the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority, otherwise known as the MMDA Law, have primacy over Section 458(5)(v-vi) of Local Government Code of 1991 which empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to enact ordinances regulating traffic within their respective Cities;

WHEREAS, it is the objective of the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Novaliches Proper to maintain peace and order in the community by way of regulating traffic scheme to avoid any untoward incident and/or misunderstanding caused by undisciplined parking in any available road spaces thereby causing obstruction.

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NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known as the “One-Side Parking Ordinance on Scheduled Days of Barangay Novaliches Proper, Quezon City.”

SECTION 2. COVERAGE. – This Ordinance shall cover all motorists, residents and non-residents of Barangay Novaliches Proper, Quezon City.

SECTION 3. ONE-SIDE PARKING STREETS. – The following are declared as one-side parking streets:

SECTION 4. OTHER PROHIBITED PARKING. –

- a. Visitors are prohibited to double park their vehicles at the designated one-side parking streets;
- b. Parking in front of any establishment, road right-of-way, public and private driveway, hospital or clinic and within four (4) meters away from a fire hydrant or public safety office or utility is likewise prohibited.

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*SECTION 5. DEPUTIZATION. – To enforce the provisions of this Ordinance, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Novaliches Proper shall designate its personnel, including, but not limited to, the Barangay Public Safety Officers (BPSOs), as its Barangay Deputized Traffic Enforcers, who shall undergo training and deputization from the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority.*

*SECTION 6. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. – The Traffic and Transport Management Department (TTMD) of Quezon City and BPSOs of Barangay Novaliches Proper, as duly deputized, shall promulgate and issue the necessary rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Ordinance.*

*SECTION 7. INSTALLATION OF SIGNAGES. – The TTMD of Quezon City and Barangay Novaliches Proper are hereby mandated to install traffic signages indicating that the said streets are regulated for the information of the motorists, drivers, vehicle owners and the public in general.*

*SECTION 8. PENALTIES. – Any person who shall illegally park a motor vehicle within the ambit of Sections 3 and 4 of this Ordinance and Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3172, S-2023, revising Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2785, S-2018 or the Revised Traffic Management Code of Quezon City, shall be liable for a fine of One Thousand Pesos (Php1,000.00), if the vehicle is attended by the driver; or Two Thousand Pesos (Php2,000.00), and impoundment of the vehicle, if unattended.*

*SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All ordinances, executive orders, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.*

*SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – If, for any reason, parts of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.*

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
