ORDINANCE NO. SP- **3445**, S-2025

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5(c) OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-3296, S-2024 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REVISING ORDINANCE NO. SP-2219, S-2013, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE 'QUEZON CITY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVES CODE OF 2013,' BY REPEALING BOOK III AND BOOK IV OF THE ORDINANCE, UPDATING THE INCENTIVES PROVIDED TO MEDIUM AND LARGE ENTERPRISES, AND DOING AWAY WITH THE CATEGORIZATION OF PIONEER AND NON-PIONEER ENTERPRISES

WHEREAS, on September 5, 2024, the Quezon City Council approved Ordinance No. SP-3296, S-2024, otherwise known as the Revised Quezon City Economic Development Incentives Code, which aims to repeal Book III (Medium and Large Enterprises) and Book IV (Investment Incentives to Qualified Products) of Ordinance No. SP-2219, S-2013;

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3296, S-2024 provides new incentive packages for Medium and Large Enterprises (MLEs) in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3296, S-2024 provides qualifications for those existing enterprises that are interested to avail of the incentive package for business expansion in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, during the Quezon City Economic Development and Investment Board (QC-EDIB) meeting for the first quarter of 2025 held on March 27, 2025, it was discussed that any existing enterprise intending to expand its operations or set up an office or additional branch in Quezon City shall be eligible to avail of incentives for business expansion, regardless of whether its principal address is located outside Quezon City;

WHEREAS, there is a continuing need to improve and update the current provisions towards the achievement of the City's socio-economic development goals, to encourage the inflow of domestic and foreign investments and to promote collaborative efforts with the private sector.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 5(c) OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-3296, S-2024. – Section 5(c) of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3296, S-2024 is hereby amended and shall be read as follows:

“c. Proof of Registration from the Securities and Exchange Commission or Department of Trade and Industry indicating its new or additional location in Quezon City.”

All other provisions of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3296, S-2024 not specifically amended shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All Quezon City ordinances, resolutions, orders, or other issuances, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, revoked, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – If, any portion or provision of this Ordinance is declared void or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not in any way affect other parts or sections of this Ordinance.
