ORDINANCE NO. SP- **3464**, S-2025

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ONE-SIDE PARKING, NO PARKING, ONE-WAY TRAFFIC DIRECTION, AND REGULATED PARKING ON PARTICULAR STREETS WITHIN BARANGAY MAHARLIKA, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that:

"Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants."



WHEREAS, Sections 5(e) and (f) of Republic Act No. 7924, creating the Metro Manila Development Authority, have primacy over Section 458(5)(v-vi) of the Local Government Code of 1991 which empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to enact ordinances regulating traffic within their respective cities;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Maharlika passed Barangay Resolution No. 2024-08-165, entitled "A Resolution Requesting the Quezon City Council to Enact an Ordinance Declaring One-Side Parking, No Parking, One-Way Traffic Direction and Regulated Parking on Certain Streets in Barangay Maharlika, District I, Quezon City";

WHEREAS, due to the continuous commercial development in the vicinity, the volume of vehicular traffic within Barangay Maharlika, District I, Quezon City has commensurately increased;

WHEREAS, designating One-Side Parking, No Parking, One-Way Traffic Direction, and Regulated Parking on particular streets will decongest traffic, avoiding unnecessary delays and loss of precious time and resources;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Maharlika consulted the Traffic and Transportation Management Department (TTMD) of Quezon City; in response, the TTMD interposed no objection on designating One-Side Parking, No Parking, One-Way Traffic Direction and Regulated Parking within Barangay Maharlika, District I, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Section 458(a)(5)(vi) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides for the powers, duties, and functions of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, which include:

"(vi) Regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon, and when necessary in the interest of public welfare, authorize the removal or encroachments and illegal constructions in public places".

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known as the "One-Side Parking, No Parking, One-Way Traffic Direction, and Regulated Parking Ordinance of Barangay Maharlika, District I, Quezon City."

SECTION 2. ONE-SIDE STREET PARKING. – One-Side Street Parking shall be applied at all times to the following streets:

Street	Direction
a. Kanlaon Street – Between Don Manuel Street and Del Monte Avenue	Southbound
b. Speaker Perez Street – Between Don Manuel and Del Monte Avenue	Northbound
c. Apo Street – Between Don Manuel and Mayon Avenue	Northbound
d. Sta. Catalina Street – Between Cordillera Street and Mayon Avenue	Eastbound
e. Malaya Street – Between Cordillera Street and Mayon Avenue	Eastbound

SECTION 3. NO PARKING. – No Parking shall be applied at all times to the following streets:

Street	Direction
a. D. Tuazon Street	Both Sides
b. N.S. Amoranto Avenue	Both Sides
c. Del Monte Avenue	Eastbound – Barangay Boundary
d. Mayon Avenue	Northbound – Barangay Boundary
e. Scout Alcaraz Street	Both Sides
f. Cordillera Street	Southbound – Barangay Boundary
g. Don Manuel Street	Westbound – Barangay Boundary
h. Kanlaon Street	Northbound
i. Apo Street	Southbound
j. Speaker Perez Street	Southbound
k. Sta. Catalina Street	Westbound
l. Malaya Street	Westbound

SECTION 4. ONE-WAY TRAFFIC. – One-Way Traffic shall be applied at all times to the following streets:

Street	Direction
a. Kanlaon Street – From N.S. Amoranto Avenue to Don Manuel Street	Southbound
b. Apo Street – From Don Manuel Street to N.S. Amoranto Avenue	Northbound
c. Apo Street – From Sta. Catalina Street to Mayon Avenue	Westbound

SECTION 5. INSTALLATION OF SIGNAGES. – *The Traffic and Transport Management Department (TTMD) and Barangay Maharlika are hereby mandated to install traffic signages indicating that the streets are regulated for information of the motorists, drivers, vehicle owners, and the public in general.*

SECTION 6. DEPUTIZATION. – *The Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Maharlika shall designate its personnel, including, but not limited to, the Barangay Public Safety Officers (BPSO), as its Barangay Deputized Traffic Enforcers, who shall undergo training and deputization from the Metro Manila Development Authority, to enforce the provisions of this Ordinance through the Quezon City Traffic and Transport Management Department.*

SECTION 7. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. – *The TTMD of Quezon City, as duly deputized, shall formulate and issue the necessary rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Ordinance.*

SECTION 8. PENALTIES. – *Any person who shall illegally park a motor vehicle within the ambit of Sections 2 and 3 of this Ordinance and Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3172, S-2023, otherwise known as the Metro Manila Traffic Code of 2023, shall be liable for a fine of One Thousand Pesos (Php1,000.00), if the vehicle is attended by the driver; or Two Thousand Pesos (Php2,000.00) and impoundment of the vehicle, if unattended.*

Any person who is operating a motor vehicle against the flow of the traffic, or oppositely traversing a road denominated as One-Way or moving in reverse opposite of the flow of traffic shall be fined Two Thousand Pesos (Php2,000.00).

A fine of Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00) shall be imposed in case the illegal counterflow caused physical injuries or damage to properties without prejudice to civil and criminal liability of the driver, registered owner or operator of the motor vehicle.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – *If, for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.*

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. – *All ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.*




