AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON MARYLAND STREET,
BARANGAY PINAGKAISAHAN, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, AND
PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, Section 458(a)(5)(iv) and (v) of Republic Act No. 7160,
otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides the
following powers, duties, and functions of the Sangguniang Panlungsod,
among others:

- "(v) Regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks,
bridges, parks and other public places and approve the
construction, improvement, repair and maintenance of
the same; x x x.
- (vi) Regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibit
encroachments or obstacles thereon, and when
necessary in the interest of public welfare, x x x."



WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Pinagkaisahan passed Resolution No. 8, Series of 2023, entitled:

“Barangay Council Resolution Requesting the Quezon City Council to declare the streets of Maryland Street as ‘One-Way Traffic Flow’ and the implementation of ‘Alternate One-Side Parking’ from corner Ermin Garcia Street going to New York Street on the right side every Monday, Wednesday and Friday (M, W, F) and on the left side every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday (T, TH, S).”

WHEREAS, the Barangay receives massive complaints due to double parking of vehicles on the aforementioned street, especially from the residents thereat and passing motorists;

WHEREAS, there is a need to implement a traffic scheme in different streets of Barangay Pinagkaisahan to restore order and discipline within the area;

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the City Government to regulate the traffic situation and road conditions within its jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE. – *This Ordinance shall be known and referred to as “Traffic Scheme in Maryland Street, Barangay Pinagkaisahan.”*

SECTION 2. REGULATION. –

A. *The following traffic and parking rules shall be implemented in Maryland Street:*

- (1) Maryland Street is hereby declared as a one-way street from corner of Ermin Garcia Street to New York Street;*
- (2) One Side, Right Side Parking from Ermin Garcia Street to New York Street every Monday, Wednesday and Friday at all times, except corner box;*
- (3) One Side, Left Side Parking from Ermin Garcia Street to New York Street every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday at all times, except corner box;*



- (4) During Sundays, allow Parking on both sides for light vehicles;
- (5) No Double Parking at any day of the week;
- (6) Heavy vehicles such as bulldozer, bus, container truck and the like for delivery is prohibited to stay for more than five (5) minutes, unless permitted by the Barangay;
- (7) Parking on the said Street is on a first-come first-served basis only and parking reservation shall not be allowed;
- (8) Unserviceable or junk vehicles shall be towed or removed to maximize parking spaces;
- (9) The opposite side of the Street as stated in items (a), (b), (c), and (d) shall be declared as Tow-Away Zone respectively; and
- (10) Parking or blocking the driveway is prohibited.

The Traffic and Transport Management Department (TTMD) and the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Pinagkaisahan are hereby directed to appropriate funds for and to install the necessary traffic signs and announcement to inform the motorists and general public of the existence and implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. DEPUTIZATION. – The Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Pinagkaisahan shall designate its personnel including but not limited to Barangay Public Safety Officers (BPSO), as its Barangay Deputized Traffic Enforcers who shall undergo training and deputization from the Metro Manila Development Authority, to enforce the provision of this Ordinance, through the TTMD.

SECTION 4. ENFORCEMENT. – This Ordinance shall be enforced and implemented by the TTMD and the Barangay Deputized Traffic Enforcers of Barangay Pinagkaisahan, who are hereby authorized and empowered to administer and implement in Barangay Pinagkaisahan all the rules and regulations herein provided.



SECTION 5. PENALTIES. –

- a. Any person who shall illegally park a motor vehicle in violation of this Ordinance and Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3172, S-2023, otherwise known as the Metro Manila Traffic Code of 2023, shall be liable for a fine of:
 - (1) One Thousand Pesos (Php1,000.00), if the vehicle is attended by the driver; and
 - (2) Two Thousand Pesos (Php2,000.00) and impoundment, if the vehicle is unattended by the driver;
- b. Any person who shall commit an act constituting “Obstruction” under Section 2 shall be liable for a fine of One Thousand Pesos (Php1,000.00);
- c. Any person who operates a motor vehicle against the flow of traffic or oppositely traversing a street denominated as one way or moving in reverse opposite of the flow of traffic shall be fined Two Thousand Pesos (Php2,000.00); and
- d. A fine of Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00) shall be imposed in case the illegal counter flow caused physical injuries or damage to properties without prejudice to civil and criminal liability of the driver, registered owner, or operator of the motor vehicle.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All existing ordinances and resolutions, local executive orders, rules and regulations inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.



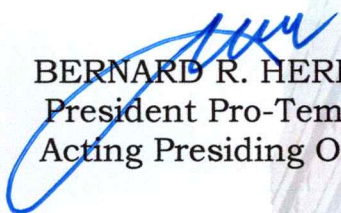
