ORDINANCE NO. SP- 3470, S-2025

AN ORDINANCE NAMING FIFTEEN (15) UNNAMED STREETS AND ALLEYS IN BARANGAY COMMONWEALTH, QUEZON CITY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH QUEZON CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-2462, S-2015, ESTABLISHING GUIDELINES IN NAMING OR RENAMING PUBLIC PLACES, STREETS, AND STRUCTURES IN THE CITY, AND IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE REVISED GUIDELINES OF THE NATIONAL HISTORICAL COMMISSION OF THE PHILIPPINES (NHCP)

WHEREAS, Section 13(b)(2) of the Local Government Code of 1991 authorizes the Sangguniang Panlungsod of highly urbanized cities, in consultation with the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), to name or rename city roads, avenues, boulevards, thoroughfares, and bridges;

WHEREAS, the Revised Guidelines on the Naming and Renaming of Streets and Other Public Places issued by the NHCP allow local government units to undertake such actions provided they observe the required procedures and criteria;

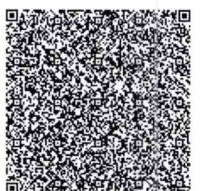

WHEREAS, the 19<sup>th</sup> Quezon City Council enacted Ordinance No. SP-2462, S-2015, otherwise known as the "Quezon City Guidelines in Naming/Renaming its Public Places, Streets, and Structures";

WHEREAS, in Barangay Commonwealth, there remain several unnamed streets and alleys that are difficult to locate and identify, affecting residents, visitors, emergency responders, and service providers;

WHEREAS, the Pinagnayun Homeowners Association, Inc. (HOA) in Barangay Commonwealth adopted Board Resolution No. 2024-11, requesting that the fifteen (15) unnamed alleys in their area be named after national and common trees, promoting tourism and enhancing social and economic activities in the area;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Commonwealth passed Resolution No. 260, Series of 2025, endorsing to the Quezon City Council the naming of the 15 unnamed streets and alleys within the Pinagnayun HOA after national and commonly known trees, along with the corresponding significance of each;

WHEREAS, upon careful consideration with the City Planning and Development Department (CPDD) that tree names are already commonly used in national and City roads, it was agreed to adopt the use of aquatic animal names, that remain underutilized within Quezon City and the Country, thereby promoting better distinction, organization, and uniqueness among local street names;

WHEREAS, consequently, the Pinagnayun HOA adopted Board Resolution No. 2025-12, changing from national and common trees to aquatic animals the names of fifteen (15) unnamed streets and alleys to constitute symbolic improvements for better progress and developments in the area;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Commonwealth passed Resolution No. 547, S-2025 approving and adopting the shifting of the proposed four (4) aquatic animal names, "Hasa-Hasa, Malasugi, Samaral and Tabios" to complete the fifteen (15) names of unnamed streets and alleys of Pinagnayun HOA;

WHEREAS, the requirements indicated in Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2462, S-2015 for the naming of streets have been completed, namely:

1. the proposed name;
2. the rationale or justification for the proposed name;
3. the documentation indicating community support; and

4. a description and/or map showing the location and boundaries of the public place;

WHEREAS, naming these streets and alleys will significantly improve area identification, promote environmental awareness through the use of national and common aquatic animal names, and support efficient mapping and navigation services.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. NAMING THE STREETS AND ALLEYS. – The following unnamed streets and alleys located within Barangay Commonwealth, District II, Quezon City, particularly under the jurisdiction of the Pinagnayun Homeowners Association, Inc., as indicated in the map forming part of this Ordinance, are hereby named as follows:

SECTION 2. INSTALLATION OF STREET SIGNAGES. – The Quezon City Department of Engineering and City General Services Department, in coordination with Barangay Commonwealth, shall install the appropriate signages on the aforementioned streets.

SECTION 3. DISSEMINATION. – The Secretary to the Sanggunian is hereby directed, upon the approval and effectivity of this Ordinance, to furnish the Office of the President, the representative of the legislative district concerned, Philippine Postal Corporation, National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), and other concerned offices with a copy of this Ordinance for their information and proper guidance, pursuant to Section 13(h) of the Local Government Code of 1991.

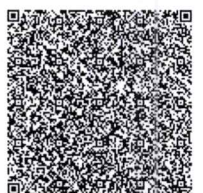
The Quezon City Public Affairs and Information Services Department (PAISD) shall disseminate this Ordinance on the official website and other media platforms of the City Government.


