ORDINANCE NO. SP- **3481**, S-2026

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ONE-WAY TRAFFIC DIRECTION IN PARTICULAR STREETS WITHIN BARANGAY DAMAYAN, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that:

"Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants."



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WHEREAS, Sections 5(e) and (f) of Republic Act No. 7924, creating the Metro Manila Development Authority, have primacy over Section 458(a)(5)(v-vi) of the Local Government Code of 1991 which empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to enact ordinances regulating traffic within their respective cities;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Damayan conducted a public consultation relevant to the proposed One-Way Traffic Direction on particular streets within their Barangay;

WHEREAS, due to the continuous commercial development in the vicinity, the volume of vehicular traffic within Barangay Damayan, District I, Quezon City has commensurately increased;

WHEREAS, designating One-Way Traffic Direction will decongest traffic, avoiding unnecessary delays and loss of precious time and resources;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay consulted the Traffic and Transport Management Department of Quezon City, and in response, the Department interposed no objection on designating One-Way Traffic Direction within Barangay Damayan, District I, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Section 458(a)(5)(vi) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides for the powers, duties, and functions of the Sangguniang Panlungsod as follows:

“(vi) Regulate traffic on all streets and bridges, prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon, and when necessary in the interest of public welfare, authorize the removal or encroachments and illegal constructions in public places.”

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known as the “One-Way Traffic Direction Ordinance of Barangay Damayan, District I, Quezon City.”









SECTION 2. ONE-WAY TRAFFIC. – One-Way Traffic shall be implemented at all times to the following streets:

Street	Direction
a. G. Felipe Sr. Street	Heading to Fernando Poe Jr. Avenue
b. San Pedro Bautista	Felipe Street heading to Del Monte Avenue
c. San Vicente Street	Del Monte Avenue heading to G. Felipe Sr. Street
d. Zamora Street	Morato Street heading to Del Monte Avenue
e. H. Francisco Street	Heading to Morato Street

SECTION 3. INSTALLATION OF SIGNAGES. – The Traffic and Transport Management Department of Quezon City and Barangay Damayan are hereby mandated to install traffic signages indicating that the streets are regulated for information of the motorists, drivers, vehicle owners, and the public in general.

SECTION 4. DEPUTIZATION. – The Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Damayan will arrange for qualified personnel, including, but not limited to, the Barangay Public Safety Officers (BPSO). The BPSO, as its Barangay Deputized Traffic Enforcers, shall undergo training and deputization from the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority through the Quezon City Traffic and Transport Management Department (QC-TTMD), to enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. ENFORCEMENT. – The Metropolitan Manila Development Authority and the Quezon City Traffic and Transport Management Department, with the assistance of Barangay Deputized Traffic Enforcers and members of the Sangguniang Barangay are hereby authorized and empowered to administer and implement the rules and regulations relative to this Barangay Damayan Traffic Management Ordinance. All existing Quezon City ordinances related to traffic management are hereby adopted.

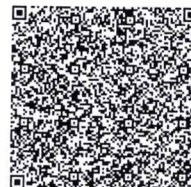
SECTION 6. PENALTIES. – Violation of any provision of this Ordinance is subject to the issuance of a Unified Ordinance Violation Receipt (UOVR), as well as payment of corresponding fines, as provided under Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3172, S-2023.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

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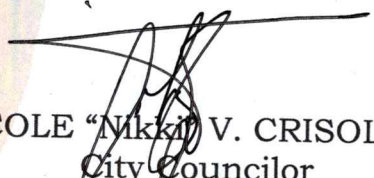

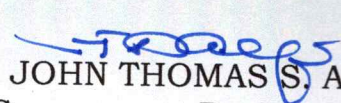

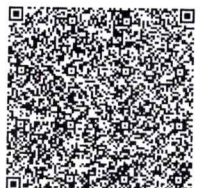
