ACHIEVEMENT AND PUBLIC SERVICE"

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3129, S-2022, otherwise
known as the Academic Achievers and Joy of Public Service Awards
Ordinance, seeks to recognize exemplary academic achievements and
leadership of Grade 6 and Grade 12 learners of Quezon City public schools
by giving incentives to the top three (3) graduating learners and exemplary
leaders;

WHEREAS, Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG)
Memorandum Circular No. 2026-006 dated January 29, 2026 reiterates the
prohibition on the display and/or affixture of the name, image, or likeness of
public officials on government-funded projects and activities;

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WHEREAS, in view of DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2026-006, there is a need to amend the short title of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3129, S-2022 to adopt a more neutral and institutional designation that avoids any reference that may be construed as identifying or alluding to a public official, thereby ensuring full compliance with national directives.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3129, S-2022 is hereby amended to read as:

“SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known as the “Academic Achievers and Leadership in Public Service Awards Ordinance.”

SECTION 2. The title and content of Section 5 thereof is hereby amended to read as:

“INCENTIVES FOR LEADERSHIP IN PUBLIC SERVICE AWARD

SECTION 5. INCENTIVES FOR LEADERSHIP IN PUBLIC SERVICE AWARD. – It is hereby institutionalized to recognize students in the Grade 6 and the Grade 12 levels who have aptly demonstrated the value of service above self by showing exemplary commitment to the service of the school, its communities and its students. The Leadership in Public Service Awardees shall be granted the following incentives.

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – If for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of the Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in force and effect.

SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All provisions, references, and designations in Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3129, S-2022, that are inconsistent with this amendatory Ordinance are hereby deemed modified accordingly.

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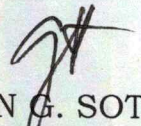


SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. – This Ordinance shall take effect after its complete publication in a newspaper of general circulation within Quezon City and after posting of copies in at least three (3) conspicuous public places within the City.
