ORDINANCE NO. SP- **3509**, S-2026

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A MONTHLY INCENTIVE ALLOWANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (PHP500.00) EACH TO ALL THE REGULAR BARANGAY PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS (BPSOs) OF THE 142 BARANGAYS IN QUEZON CITY FOR THE YEARS 2026-2028, AND APPROPRIATING THE FUNDS NECESSARY THEREFOR

WHEREAS, Section 11, Article XIII of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines expressly provides that the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development and its protection, and shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services available to all;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 likewise empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to promote and protect the general welfare of its inhabitants, specifically by enacting legislative measures;

WHEREAS, our City recognizes the role played by our Barangay Public Safety Officers (BPSOs) and such protection and welfare should likewise be extended to them, whose life and limb are often put at risk, being the frontline workers in the maintenance of peace and order;

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WHEREAS, such additional incentive will further ensure the faithful discharge of their constitutionally-sanctioned function to protect the safety and security of the residents of this City;

WHEREAS, the City Council already passed and approved Quezon City Resolution No. SP-8053, S-2019, authorizing the City Mayor to grant a Five Hundred Peso (Php500.00) monthly incentive allowance each to all regular BPSOs of the 142 Barangays in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3178, S-2023 granted said monthly allowance for the years 2023-2025;

WHEREAS, the grant of said allowance is one of the programs in the Quezon City Peace and Order and Public Safety (QC POPS) Plan for 2026-2028.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known as the “BPSO Incentive Ordinance for Years 2026-2028.”

SECTION 2. COVERAGE. – All regular Barangay Public Safety Officers (BPSOs) shall mean those designated and under plantilla positions of the 142 Barangays in Quezon City. They shall be entitled to a monthly incentive allowance of Five Hundred Pesos (Php500.00) for the years 2026-2028, which will be released by the City on a quarterly basis.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. – The funds necessary for the grant of the monthly incentive allowance shall be chargeable against the Quezon City Peace and Order and Public Safety (QC POPS) Plan for the years 2026-2028, under the Office of the City Mayor.

SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders, rules and regulations, or any part thereof inconsistent herewith are deemed repealed, modified, or amended accordingly.

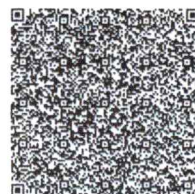
SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – In case any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

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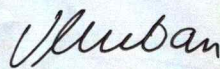


SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after the publication requirements have been complied with.
