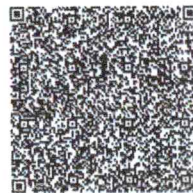
AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ONE-SIDE PARKING SCHEME ALONG THE STREETS OF BARANGAY DOÑA IMELDA, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that:

"Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants."



WHEREAS, Section 458(a)(5)(vi) of the Local Government Code of 1991, provides for some of the powers, duties, and functions of the Sangguniang Panlungsod:

“(vi) Regulate traffic on all streets and bridges, prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon, and when necessary, in the interest of public welfare, authorize the removal or encroachments and illegal constructions in public places.”

WHEREAS, Sections 5(e) and (f) of Republic Act No. 7924, creating the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority, have primacy over Section 458(a)(5)(v-vi) of the Local Government Code of 1991 which empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to enact ordinances regulating traffic within their respective cities;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council approved Ordinance No. SP-2280, S-2014 as introduced by the Honorable City Councilor Raquel S. Malañgen; it allows the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Doña Imelda to regulate the use of streets within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, double parking is rampant along the streets of Barangay Doña Imelda and this contributes to the problems of the transportation sector; vehicles park without consideration in front of driveways, blind corners, intersections, and the like;

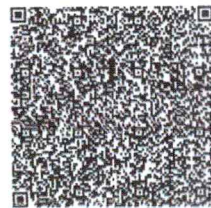
WHEREAS, the inconsiderate and flagrant parking of vehicles on barangay streets despite the fact that the streets are used for mobile vehicles and not as parking spaces causes traffic congestion along the streets of Barangay Doña Imelda;

WHEREAS, after a detailed study and assessment of the aforementioned parking and traffic problems and situations on the streets of the Barangay, the Sangguniang Barangay, through its Committee on Transportation, deemed it necessary to implement a One-Side Parking Scheme within the jurisdiction of Barangay Doña Imelda to alleviate the current traffic and parking situation in the Barangay.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known as the “Barangay Doña Imelda One-Side Parking Ordinance.”



SECTION 2. COVERAGE. – This Ordinance shall apply to all motor vehicles parking along the streets of Barangay Doña Imelda.

SECTION 3. ONE-SIDE PARKING SCHEME. –

Kapiligan – From Araneta to Corner Guirayan	Left Side
Kapiligan – From Corner Guirayan to Guirayan Mezza	Right Side
Balabac – From Kapiligan to Luntan	Right Side
Bituan – From Kapiligan to Bayani	Left Side
Guirayan – From Kapiligan to Aurora	Right Side
Luntan – From Guirayan to Kapiligan	Right Side
Bayani – From Guirayan to Kapiligan	Right Side
Ugo – From Guirayan to Kapiligan	Right Side
Pawoi – From Guirayan to Kapiligan	Right Side
Baloy – From Guirayan to Kapiligan	Right Side
Landargun – From Araneta to Kapiligan	Left Side
Palanza – From Guirayan to Kapiligan	Left Side
Lantawan – From Guirayan to Kapiligan	Left Side
Tomas Arguelles – From Bayani to Araneta	Left Side

SECTION 4. SIGNS. – Signages will be placed or installed in conspicuous places along the streets of Barangay Doña Imelda.

SECTION 5. DEPUTIZATION. – The Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Doña Imelda shall designate its personnel, including, but not limited to, the Barangay Public Safety Officers (BPSO), as its Barangay Deputized Traffic Enforcers, who shall undergo training and deputization from the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority, to enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. ENFORCEMENT. – After having been duly deputized by the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority, the Traffic and Transport Management Department of Quezon City, with the assistance of the Barangay Traffic Enforcers and the members of the Sangguniang Barangay, is hereby authorized and empowered to administer and implement all rules and regulations relative to Barangay Doña Imelda Traffic Management Ordinance. All existing Quezon City ordinances related to Traffic Management are hereby adopted.

SECTION 7. PENALTIES. – Violation of any provision of this Ordinance shall be penalized with a fine of One Thousand Pesos (Php1,000.00), if attended by the driver; or Two Thousand Pesos (Php2,000.00) and impoundment of the vehicle, if unattended in accordance with Section 11(h) of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3172, S-2023, also known as the Quezon City Traffic Code of 2023.



SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

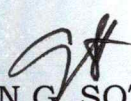
SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. – This Ordinance, being an ordinance with penal sanctions, shall take effect on the day following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation, or upon completion of its posting for three (3) consecutive weeks in the manner required by law, whichever occurs later, pursuant to Sections 59 and 511 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

The Secretary to the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall cause the posting, publication, recording, and transmission of this Ordinance in accordance with the Local Government Code of 1991, including the posting thereof at the bulletin board of the Quezon City Hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous public places within Quezon City, the publication of its gist, main features, or full text in a newspaper of general circulation, and the posting of the same for at least three (3) consecutive weeks as an ordinance with penal sanctions.

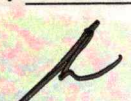
