WHEREAS, Quezon City Science High School (QCSHS), also referred to as "QueSci" or "Kisay," was established in 1967, and has served as the Regional Science High School for the National Capital Region since 1998. It stands as the leading science high school in Quezon City and holds recognition as one of the esteemed science triumvirate institutions in the Philippines, alongside the Philippine Science High School and Manila Science High School;

WHEREAS, QCSHS was established to offer greater opportunities for gifted students with an interest in science, mathematics, and technology. It provides tuition-free education as a public institution. Its admission process is rigorously competitive, requiring exceptional academic performance, exemplary moral character, and residency within the National Capital Region. Consequently, gaining admission and graduating from this esteemed institution represents a remarkable accomplishment and testament to the dedication and capability of its students;

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2025, the 8th Commencement Exercises of QCSHS were held at the QCSHS Dome, during which Marc Abrielle F. Juan of Grade 12-Section Kepler was honored as valedictorian of the 2025 graduating class, comprising 301 students, in recognition of his exceptional academic performance. He also received other top awards for his achievements in academic excellence, service, and leadership during the ceremony, such as the Dr. Angel C. Alcala Academic Excellence in Science Award, Work Immersion Award, and Leadership Award;


