A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF KING SOLOMON SPORTS CENTER CORPORATION (STA. MONICA COCKPIT) FOR THE OPERATION OF ITS BUSINESS LOCATED AT NO. 26 SARMIENTO STREET, BARANGAY STA. MONICA, DISTRICT V, QUEZON CITY FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS RECKONED FROM THE DATE OF APPROVAL OF THIS RESOLUTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS AND SUBJECT TO THE PAYMENT OF CORRESPONDING TAXES, FEES AND OTHER CHARGES THEREFOR

WHEREAS, King Solomon Sports Center Corporation (Sta. Monica Cockpit), a duly organized corporation existing under Philippines Laws, is applying for the renewal of its Special Permit for the operation of Sta. Monica Cockpit located at No. 26 Sarmiento Street, Barangay Sta. Monica, District V, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, King Solomon Sports Center Corporation (Sta. Monica Cockpit), the only duly licensed cockpit in Quezon City, has been in operation for twenty (20) years, has gained an impressive reputation in the cock fighting industry;

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-1223, S-2002, grants the Solomon Sports and Leisure Corporation (Sta. Monica Cockpit) a 25-year franchise to establish, construct, operate and maintain a sports center and arena; likewise, the applicant was previously granted a Fixed-Term Special Permit by the Quezon City Council for the operation of the same business through of Quezon City Resolution No. SP-9219, S-2023;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to continue its business operations, there is a need to renew the Special Permit granted by the City Council;

WHEREAS, the grant of a Special Permit to King Solomon Sports Center Corporation (Sta. Monica Cockpit) will mean continued remittance of taxes, fees and other charges to the City Government.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of King Solomon Sports Center Corporation (Sta. Monica Cockpit) for the operation of its business located at No. 26 Sarmiento Street, Barangay Sta. Monica, District V, Quezon City for a period of three (3) years reckoned from the date of approval of this Resolution in accordance with the existing laws, rules and regulations and subject to the payment of corresponding taxes, fees and other charges therefor.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Fixed-Term Special Permit granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions, to wit:

1. the holding of Cockpit shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by the Games and Amusement Board (GAB);
2. the operation of a Cockpit establishment is enjoined to prohibit from playing the abovementioned games in their gaming site individuals below 21 years of age or students of any school, college or university;
3. this Resolution is non-assignable, non-transferrable and site-address specific;
4. the establishment and its operation shall not be a nuisance to public safety and order;



5. the establishment shall comply with all clearance, documentary requirements and other applicable local and national laws; and
6. the cockpit establishment shall strictly enforce the use of available modern technology including but not limited to digital or automated closed-circuit betting system accessible solely within the cockpit to prevent the possible transmission of infectious disease.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that this renewal of a Special Permit granted to King Solomon Sports Center Corporation (Sta. Monica Cockpit) shall be subject to the conditions set forth by the Gambling Regulatory Advisory Council (GRAC) Resolution and Letter of No Objection issued by the Business Permits and Licensing Department (BPLD).
