A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF PHILIPPINES IVISION INCORPORATED TO OPERATE AN ELECTRONIC GAMES ESTABLISHMENT LOCATED AT 2ND FLOOR PWESTO COMMUNITY MALL, NO. 56 HOLY SPIRIT DRIVE, BARANGAY HOLY SPIRIT, DISTRICT II, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR)

WHEREAS, Philippines Ivision Incorporated, a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine laws, is applying for the renewal of its Special Permit to operate an Electronic Games establishment located at 2nd Floor Pwesto Community Mall, No. 56 Holy Spirit Drive, Barangay Holy Spirit, District II, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the applicant was previously granted a Special Permit by the Quezon City Council for the operation of the same Electronic Games establishment through Quezon City Resolution No. SP-9350, S-2023;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to continue its business operations, there is a need to renew its Special Permit pursuant to an existing City ordinance;

WHEREAS, the operation of an Electronic Games establishment is regulated and licensed by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR);

WHEREAS, the aforementioned business activity will provide employment and additional revenue to the City Government;

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended, and Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, authorize the Quezon City Council to grant or renew a Special Permit to business activities of the same nature.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of Philippines Ivision Incorporated for the operation of an Electronic Games establishment located at 2nd Floor Pwesto Community Mall No. 56 Holy Spirit Drive, Barangay Holy Spirit, District II, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the authority to operate an Electronic Games establishment granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions, to wit:


1. the holding of Electronic Games shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;
2. the operation of an Electronic Games establishment shall not include the playing of games not related to or other than Electronic Games;
3. the operation is enjoined to prohibit from playing the abovementioned games in their gaming site individuals below 21 years of age or students of any school, college or university;
4. Philippines Ivision Incorporated shall remit a license fee of three percent (3%) of the gross receipt of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasurer's Office during the lifetime of this Resolution, in accordance with Section 25, Article III of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended;
5. this Resolution is non-assignable, non-transferrable and site-address specific; and
6. the establishment shall not be a nuisance to public safety and order.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that this renewal of a Special Permit to operate an Electronic Games establishment shall be valid for a period of three (3) years from the approval of this Resolution and may be renewed by the Quezon City Council.
