A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, REPRESENTING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (QCG), TO ENTER INTO A DEED OF DONATION WITH THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DISTRICT (QCPD) FOR THE DONATION OF CERTAIN FIREARMS AND TO TRANSFER THE OWNERSHIP THEREOF TO THE RECIPIENT WITHOUT COST

WHEREAS, Local Government Units (LGUs) have the duty to maintain peace and order within their respective territorial jurisdictions, as mandated by Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, to effectively and efficiently maintain peace and order in Quezon City and to further enhance the capability of the officers and members of the Quezon City Police District (QCPD) in the discharge of its official duties, there is an imperative need to provide the QCPD with the necessary support and equipment by way of firearms distribution or donation;

WHEREAS, through the administration of the City's successive local chief executives from the years 2003 to 2020, the Quezon City Government (QCG) gradually acquired or procured Two Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Five (2,465) assorted firearms which are already in the custody of the QCPD;

WHEREAS, the donation of the subject firearms is essential not only for the transfer of ownership thereof from the QCG to the QCPD, but for its proper registration and accountability;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455(b)(1)(vi) of the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, representing the Quezon City Government (QCG), to enter into a Deed of Donation with the Quezon City Police District (QCPD) for the donation of certain firearms and to transfer the ownership thereof to the recipient without cost.


