A RESOLUTION LIFTING THE STATE OF CALAMITY IN QUEZON CITY

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, provides that the declaration and lifting of the State of Calamity may be issued by the local sanggunian upon the recommendation of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, based on the results of the damage assessment and needs analysis;

WHEREAS, in July 2025, Quezon City was severely affected by the onslaught of Severe Tropical Storm Wipha (local name: Crising), compounded by the Enhanced Southwest Monsoon (Habagat), resulting in widespread flooding, destruction of property, mass evacuation of residents, loss of livelihood, and disruption of essential services;

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2025, the City Council declared a State of Calamity in Quezon City through Resolution No. SP-10181, S-2025 upon recommendation of the Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (QCDRRMC);

WHEREAS, the declaration facilitated the effective mobilization of resources, access to calamity funds, and implementation of emergency and recovery measures;

WHEREAS, since the declaration, the Quezon City Government, in coordination with national government agencies has conducted comprehensive disaster response and recovery efforts, resulting in significant improvements in the affected areas;

WHEREAS, on August 4, 2025, the QCDRRMC issued Resolution No. 9, S. 2025 recommending the lifting of the State of Calamity in Quezon City upon determining that the recovery phase has reached a point where Quezon City no longer requires the provisions and aid facilitated under the State of Calamity, and that the City's resources and operational capacities are now sufficient for continued rehabilitation and recovery;

WHEREAS, the lifting of the State of Calamity will enable the local government to resume regular operations and governance and redirect resources to other essential services and development programs;

WHEREAS, the declaration of a State of Calamity would facilitate the effective mobilization of resources, access to calamity funds, control prices of basic commodities, and implementation of emergency and recovery measures.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to lift, as it does hereby lift, the State of Calamity in Quezon City.


