WHEREAS, in the recently concluded Palarong Pambansa 2025 held in Ilocos Norte, Mar Aviel Carredo made a remarkable record by winning six (6) gold medals, the first time in the history of the said chess event that a single athlete achieved a clean sweep of all gold medals;
