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WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government-National Capital Region (DILG-NCR), together with the Regional Inter-Agency Monitoring Team-NCR, conducted the Local Committee Against Trafficking and Violence Against Women and their Children (LCAT-VAWC) Functionality Assessment for Performance Year 2024;

WHEREAS, the said assessment evaluated a local government unit's performance based on the criteria of organization, meetings, policies, plans and budget, and accomplishment, in accordance with the mandates of Republic Act No. 9208, as amended by Republic Act No. 10364, and Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2999, S-2020;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, under the leadership of the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, the City Vice Mayor, Honorable Gian G. Sotto, the Social Services Development Department (SSDD) as Vice Chairperson, and the Members of the Quezon City Council on Anti-Trafficking (QCCAT), garnered an overall score of 110.00 points and earned the adjectival rating of "Highly Functional" in the 2024 LCAT-VAWC Functionality Assessment;

WHEREAS, the exemplary performance of the QCCAT serves as a model of effective local governance in advancing human dignity, safeguarding vulnerable sectors, and upholding the rights and welfare of all constituents.

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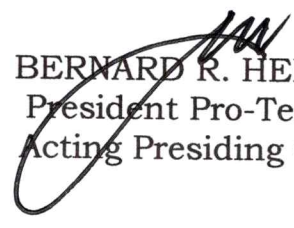
