A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2025 ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (QCG) FOR SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 1 IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE BILLION FOUR HUNDRED TWELVE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIVE PESOS (PHP1,412,701,905.00) COVERING THE VARIOUS EXPENDITURES FOR THE OPERATION OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, Section 115 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that “the Department of Budget and Management shall furnish the various local development councils, information on financial resources and budgetary allocations applicable to their respective jurisdictions to guide them in their planning functions”;

WHEREAS, Section 455(b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160 states that “the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance”;

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WHEREAS, the Annual Investment Program (AIP) is a legal instrument by which a local government unit (LGU) annually manages and financially supports its Local Development Plan (LDP) and Local Development Investment Program (LDIP);

WHEREAS, after a careful review of the AIP for Supplemental Budget No. 1 for Fiscal Year 2025 of the Quezon City Government, it was found out to be in order and in consonance with the City development thrusts;

WHEREAS, it is imperative for the Sangguniang Panlungsod to adopt the AIP for Supplemental Budget No. 1 for Fiscal Year 2025 of Quezon City, in support of the City Government's programs and projects.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to adopt, as it does hereby adopt, the 2025 Annual Investment Program (AIP) of the Quezon City Government (QCG) for Supplemental Budget No. 1 in the amount of One Billion Four Hundred Twelve Million Seven Hundred One Thousand Nine Hundred Five Pesos (Php1,412,701,905.00) covering the various expenditures for the operation of the Quezon City Government and appropriating the necessary funds for the purpose, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations.
