A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO DONATE THIRTY-FIVE (35) TENTS TO THIRTY-FIVE (35) RECIPIENTS FROM DIFFERENT BARANGAYS IN THE 1ST DISTRICT OF QUEZON CITY AND TO EFFECT THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP THEREOF WITHOUT COST TO THE RECIPIENTS

WHEREAS, Section 22(4)(5)(c) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that every local government unit shall, as a corporation, have the powers to acquire and convey real or personal property, to enter into contracts, and unless otherwise provided in the said Code, no contract may be entered into by the Local Chief Executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the Sanggunian concerned;

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive may, upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, negotiate and secure financial grants or donation in kind in support of basic services or facilities enumerated in Section 17 of the Local Government Code of 1991;

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WHEREAS, under Section 17 of the Local Government Code of 1991, local government units may exercise such powers and discharge such functions as may be necessary, appropriate of incidental to the delivery of basic services and facilities including tax and information systems;

WHEREAS, in order to safeguard the welfare of residents against exposure to rain and sunlight, particularly during evacuation necessitated by flooding brought about by the storms or typhoons, thirty-five (35) tents were duly procured and acquired through the funds allocated from the office of Councilor Dorothy A. Delarmente, M.D.;

WHEREAS, for the proper turn over of the ownership of the donated items to the recipients from different barangays, as Donee, a Deed of Donation shall be executed, with the City, as Donor, assuming all fees and cost;

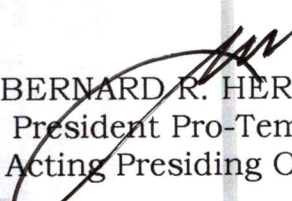
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to donate thirty-five (35) tents to thirty-five (35) recipients from different barangays in the 1st District of Quezon City and to effect the transfer of ownership thereof without cost to the recipients.
