WHEREAS, Section 22(a)(4) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that every local government unit shall, as a corporation, have the power to acquire and convey real or personal property;

WHEREAS, Quezon City Council Resolution No. SP-8630, S-71 advocates for the sale of vehicle and equipment to government officials, officers and employees should they be willing to purchase the same at the appraisal value provided that the tax payable due to the government shall be shouldered by the purchaser;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government issued one (1) motor vehicle to the City Treasurer, Edgar T. Villanueva, throughout his term as Quezon City Treasurer up to present to perform his duties in the City Treasurer's Office of Quezon City. The subject vehicle is hereunder described:


