A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO DONATE OR TRANSFER, WITHOUT COST, TWO (2) UNITS OF FIRE TRUCK TO THE QUEZON CITY FIRE DISTRICT AND TO TURN OVER DOCUMENTS PERTINENT TO THEIR OWNERSHIP

WHEREAS, Section 22(4)(5)(c) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every local government unit shall, as a corporation, have the powers to acquire and convey real or personal property, to enter into contracts, and unless otherwise provided in the said Code, no contract may be entered into by the Local Chief Executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the Sanggunian concerned;

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive may, upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, negotiate and secure financial grants or donation in kind in support of basic services or facilities enumerated in Section 17 of the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 51(2), Book I of Executive Order No. 292, otherwise known as the Administrative Code of 1987, the Honorable City Mayor is authorized to enter into contracts;

WHEREAS, under Section 17 of the Local Government Code of 1991, a local government unit may exercise such powers and discharge such functions as may be necessary, appropriate or incidental to the delivery of basic services and facilities including tax and information systems;

WHEREAS, the previously enacted Quezon City Resolution No. SP-10106, S-2025, which authorizes the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte to execute the Deed of Donation for four (4) units of fire trucks in favor of the Quezon City Fire District (QCFD), without cost, and to turn over all documents pertinent to their ownership, subject to existing laws, rules, and regulations, clearly manifests the City's unwavering commitment to the prevention and eradication of fire incidents;

WHEREAS, the donation of the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, is to support the prevention of fire emergencies in line with Quezon City's disaster and emergency response capabilities such as QC 122;

WHEREAS, two (2) units of Fire Truck described below were recently turned over by the Quezon City Government to the Quezon City Fire District:

WHEREAS, these fire truck units are used by the QCFD to carry out effectively its duties particularly during rescue operations in time of fire and related catastrophes;

WHEREAS, upon donation, the QCFD shall bear all expenses relative to insurance, registration, maintenance, as well as incidental fees relative to the transfer of ownership;

NOW, THEREFORE,




