*WHEREAS, Alexandra "Alex" Eala, a proud daughter of Quezon City and the Philippines, has once again brought immense pride and honor to the City and to the entire Country by capturing her first-ever Women's Tennis Association (WTA) singles title at the Guadalajara 125 Open held in Guadalajara, Mexico on September 7, 2025 (Philippine time);*

*WHEREAS, Eala achieved this historic milestone by defeating Hungary's Panna Udvardy in a thrilling final match, overcoming a first-set loss to prevail with a score of 1-6, 7-5, 6-3, showcasing her resilience, athleticism, and world-class talent;*

*WHEREAS, with this breakthrough, Alex Eala became the first Filipino player in history to win a WTA singles title, an achievement that significantly elevates the Philippines' presence in the global tennis community;*


NOW, THEREFORE,
