WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council, headed by the City Vice Mayor, Honorable Gian G. Sotto, formulated a Legislative Agenda constituted with the five (5) clusters outlined in Executive Order No. 17, s-2025, to wit:

1. **Human and Social Services**
 - a. **Poverty Reduction and Social Development;**
 - b. **Security, Peace, and Disaster Preparedness;**



2. *Economic Development;*
3. *Environment and Climate Change;*
4. *Infrastructure, Urban Planning and Development; and*
5. *Institutional Development;*

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2025, the Legislative Agenda was formulated through consultations of the City Council with national government agencies, non-government organizations (NGOs), civil society organizations (CSOs), people's organizations (POs) and other sectors;

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2025, the Office of the City Vice Mayor presented the Legislative Agenda of the 23rd Quezon City Council during the harmonization of the executive and legislative priorities for the Local Governance Canvass;

WHEREAS, the Legislative Agenda outlines the priority policy direction of the current administration aligned with the local executive and national government priorities for the sustainable and inclusive development of the City and the Country;

WHEREAS, it is imperative for the City Council to adopt the Quezon City Legislative Agenda for CY 2025-2028 to ensure that the thrusts of the City Mayor are supported by laws and that council-initiated legislation are successfully implemented.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to adopt, as it does hereby adopt, the Legislative Agenda of the 23rd Quezon City Council for Calendar Year 2025-2028.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the attached Legislative Agenda be made an integral part of this Resolution.
