A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE SOLIDARITY OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT WITH THE PRINCIPLES OF GOOD GOVERNANCE, TRANSPARENCY, AND ACCOUNTABILITY AND AFFIRMING ITS COMMITMENT TO LIFESTYLE CHECKS, PROPER MANAGEMENT OF PUBLIC FUNDS, AND THE CONTINUOUS PROMOTION OF POLICIES FOR THE BETTERMENT OF THE PEOPLE OF QUEZON CITY

WHEREAS, Section 27, Article II of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines declares that the State shall maintain honesty and integrity in public service and take positive and effective measures against graft and corruption;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, vests in local government units the responsibility to exercise powers and discharge functions in a manner that promotes accountability, transparency, and efficiency in the delivery of services;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 6713, otherwise known as the Code of Conduct and Ethical Standards for Public Officials and Employees, mandates all public servants to uphold a standard of honesty, integrity, and accountability in the conduct of public service;

WHEREAS, Quezon City, being the largest local government unit in Metro Manila, recognizes the urgent need to strengthen public trust by ensuring that government resources are managed judiciously, public officials remain beyond reproach through regular lifestyle checks, and government programs directly uplift the welfare of its citizens;

WHEREAS, citizen trust is the cornerstone of effective governance, and Quezon City acknowledges that transparency, participatory mechanisms, and open access to information empower citizens to become active partners in monitoring, evaluating, and shaping government programs;

WHEREAS, prudent fiscal management and strong internal controls ensure that every Peso from the people's coffers is directed to priority programs in health, education, infrastructure, disaster resilience, social welfare, and inclusive economic growth;

WHEREAS, the conduct of lifestyle checks for City officials and employees is an effective mechanism to deter corruption, uphold integrity, and promote a culture of accountability across all levels of governance;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is determined to institutionalize policies and mechanisms that will guarantee clean governance, efficient use of resources, and proactive citizen engagement in the planning, implementation, and assessment of City programs.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to express, as it does hereby express, the solidarity of the Quezon City Government with the principles of good governance, transparency, and accountability and affirming its commitment to lifestyle checks, proper management of public funds, and the continuous promotion of policies for the betterment of the people of Quezon City, as follows:

1. The Quezon City Government hereby expresses its solidarity with the principles of good governance, transparency, and accountability, affirming its commitment to strengthen lifestyle checks and ethical conduct among City officials and employees.



2. The City Government reiterates its firm resolve to ensure proper and judicious management of public funds, guaranteeing that government expenditures are prioritized for programs that directly benefit Quezon City residents, particularly in essential services such as health, education, social protection, digitalization, and infrastructure.
3. The City Government shall institutionalize citizen participation in governance by fostering partnerships with civil society, business, academe, and community organizations to ensure that public policies and programs are people-centered, transparent, and inclusive.
4. The City Mayor is hereby authorized to issue the appropriate orders and take the necessary measures to strengthen internal control systems, conduct periodic lifestyle checks, and reinforce fiscal accountability in the City Government.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to the Office of the City Mayor, the Commission on Audit (COA), the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), the Office of the Ombudsman, and other concerned offices for their information and guidance.
