A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE SINCEREST COMMENDATION AND CONGRATULATIONS OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, HEADED BY THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. MAGLINAO ON HIS ELECTION AS THE 2026 NATIONAL PRESIDENT OF JCI PHILIPPINES

WHEREAS, Atty. Patrick DL. Maglinao is a lawyer, public servant, and academician, who was recently elected last September 7, 2025 as the 2026 National President of Junior Chamber International (JCI) Philippines, the largest organization of young leaders, professionals, and entrepreneurs in the Country, committed to its mission of providing leadership development opportunities that empower young people to create positive change and guided by its vision to be the foremost global network of young leaders;

WHEREAS, the position of National President of JCI Philippines is a significant role that enables the implementation of relevant, meaningful, sustainable and impactful projects addressing national and local concerns, while giving Quezon City opportunities to benefit from innovative programs, stronger civic partnerships, and greater recognition as a hub of leadership and volunteerism;

WHEREAS, with the Philippines hosting the 2026 JCI World Congress, his presidency offers a historic chance to showcase Filipino culture, leadership, and civic initiatives on the global stage, further positioning Quezon City and the Nation as a cradle of transformative leadership;

WHEREAS, Atty. Maglinao was admitted to the Philippine Bar in 2013. He pursued a Master of Laws (LL.M.) at the University of California, Berkeley School of Law, where he specialized in intellectual property law;

WHEREAS, he has also worked at several law offices, including the Mendoza Antero Law Office, Aquende Yebra Aniang Loon and Associates, and Quicho Law Offices;

WHEREAS, as a public servant, he has held a position as a law professor at the University of the East and has been an in-demand speaker and lecturer at Mandatory Continuing Legal Education seminars, often presenting on topics such as land titles and deeds;

WHEREAS, before his election as the 2026 National President of JCI Philippines, Atty. Maglinao held several leadership positions within the organization, serving as the 2025 National Executive Vice President, 2024 Area Vice President for the Metro Area, and 2023 Local Organization President of JCI Quezon City Capitol;

WHEREAS, he was also a recipient of the Quezon City Government Local Outstanding Volunteers Award in 2023 for his unwavering volunteerism and dedicated service, which directly uplifted the lives of fellow Quezon City citizens;

WHEREAS, the accomplishments of Atty. Maglinao bring pride and honor not only to JCI Quezon City Capitol but also to the entire Quezon City, showcasing the City as a source of transformative leaders who serve the Nation;

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper for the Quezon City Council to recognize and commend the achievements of Atty. Patrick DL. Maglinao.
