A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING HONORABLE ALY V. MEDALLA AS THE PRIMARY REPRESENTATIVE, WHILE HONORABLE JOSEPH P. JUICO AS THE ALTERNATIVE REPRESENTATIVE, AND AS AMONG VOTING MEMBERS OF THE QUEZON CITY PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP PRE-QUALIFICATION, BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE (QC PPP PBAC) AND PPP UNIT

WHEREAS, under Section 20, Article II of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines provides that the State recognizes the indispensable role of the private sector, encourages private enterprise, and provides incentives to needed investments;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11966, otherwise known as the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) Code of the Philippines, recognizes the autonomy of Local Government Units (LGUs) in entering and implementing local PPP projects in the pursuit of their goals as self-reliant communities and effective partners in national development;

WHEREAS, Section 8 of Republic Act No. 11966 mandates that the head of the Implementing Agency undertaking PPP Projects shall create a PPP Pre-qualification, Bids, and Awards Committee (PBAC), which shall be responsible for all aspects of pre-bidding and bidding process in Solicited Proposals or the comparative bidding process in Unsolicited Proposals;

WHEREAS, Sections 4(jj) and 12 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 11966 provides that the head of the implementing agency for Local PPP Projects shall be the Local Chief Executive and, at his/her discretion create and organize a PBAC for local PPP Project;

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2025, City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, issued Executive Order (EO) No. 4, Series of 2025, creating and organizing the Quezon City PPP PBAC and PPP Unit. Section 1 of the said EO provides the constitution of the Quezon City PPP PBAC members that includes, among others, a representative, as voting member, from the Sangguniang Panlungsod designated through a City Resolution;

WHEREAS, in compliance with EO No. 4, Series of 2025 issued by the City Mayor and the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 11966, the Quezon City Council designated the Majority Floor Leader of the 23rd City Council, Honorable Aly V. Medalla as the primary representative, while Honorable Joseph P. Juico as the alternative representative, from the 23rd Sangguniang Panlungsod and considered as among the voting members of the Quezon City PPP PBAC and PPP Unit.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to designate, as it does hereby designate, Honorable Aly V. Medalla as the primary representative, while Honorable Joseph P. Juico as the alternative representative, and as among voting members of the Quezon City Public-Private Partnership Pre-Qualification, Bids and Awards Committee (QC PPP PBAC) and PPP unit.
