BELMONTE, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE PHILIPPINE SPORTS COMMISSION FOR THE CASH INCENTIVES TO BE GRANTED TO THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT WHICH WON 3RD PLACE IN THE OVERALL OFFICIAL MEDAL TALLY IN THE BATANG PINOY 2024 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS HELD IN PUERTO PRINCESA, PROVINCE OF PALAWAN

WHEREAS, the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC), by virtue of Republic Act No. 6847, encourages wide participation of all sectors, government and private, in amateur sports promotion and development, and provides incentives, recognitions and awards to deserving associations, athletes, referees, game officials, coaches, trainers and other persons or entities involved in or supporting sports development as may be permissible under the rules of amateurism;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 44, Series of 1998, issued by the Office of the President, created the Philippine Youth Games – Batang Pinoy as an integral part of the national policy and program for sports development which will effectively address the Country’s need for a comprehensive grassroots sports program centered on values formation, inherent in the practice of sports and play, such as patriotism, nationalism, self-discipline, respect for law and order, hard work, teamwork, camaraderie, sportsmanship, and fair play, thus eliminating the child’s chances of becoming a juvenile delinquent;

WHEREAS, the PSC, in partnership with the Provincial Government of Palawan, hosted and organized the Batang Pinoy 2024 National Championships held in Puerto Princesa, Province of Palawan from November 23 to 28, 2024;

WHEREAS, the PSC grants incentives to the Top 5 local government units (LGUs) in the Batang Pinoy 2024 National Championships based on the overall official medal tally, to be used for the LGUs’ grassroots sports promotion, development, and talent identification programs;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government participated in the Batang Pinoy 2024 National Championships and won 3rd Place in the overall official medal tally;

WHEREAS, there is a need for the City Council to grant authority to the City Mayor for, and in behalf of, the Quezon City Government, before signing the Memorandum of Agreement;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455(b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, authority to the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement with the Philippine Sports Commission for the cash incentives to be granted to the Quezon City Government which won 3rd Place in the overall official medal tally in the Batang Pinoy 2024 National Championships held in Puerto Princesa, Province of Palawan.
