A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (QCG) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026 IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY-SIX BILLION NINE HUNDRED TWO MILLION NINE HUNDRED FORTY-ONE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP56,902,941,000.00) COVERING THE VARIOUS EXPENDITURES FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE, SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, Section 455(b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160 states that the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;


NOW, THEREFORE,
