A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO DONATE AND/OR TRANSFER WITHOUT COST TWO (2) UNITS OF PRISONER VANS TO THE QUEZON CITY BUREAU OF JAIL MANAGEMENT AND PENOLOGY AND TO TURN OVER DOCUMENTS PERTINENT TO ITS OWNERSHIP


WHEREAS, Section 22(a)(4),(5), and (c) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every local government unit, as a corporation, shall have the power to acquire and convey real or personal property, to enter into contracts, and that no such contract may be entered into by the local chief executive on behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the Sanggunian concerned;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23 of the same Code, the local chief executive may, upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, negotiate and secure financial grants or donations in support of basic services or facilities enumerated under Section 17 thereof;

WHEREAS, Section 51(b) of the Administrative Code of 1987 further authorizes the City Mayor to enter into contracts on behalf of the local government, subject to applicable laws, rules, and regulations;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160 empowers local government units to exercise such powers and discharge such functions as may be necessary, appropriate, or incidental to the efficient and effective delivery of basic services and facilities, which include, among others, programs and measures relative to peace and order, public safety, and jail management;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (QC-BJMP), being the principal government agency responsible for the administration and safekeeping of detainees and inmates, stands to directly benefit from the use of additional vehicles to ensure the secure and efficient transport of persons deprived of liberty;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government owns two (2) units of Hyundai H100 Prisoner Vans with the following details:

WHEREAS, said Prisoner Vans are essential to the transport and safekeeping of persons deprived of liberty and will greatly assist the QC-BJMP in effectively discharging its mandate of ensuring secure, safe, and humane management of jail facilities;


WHEREAS, upon donation, the QC-BJMP shall assume full responsibility for all expenses relative to the insurance, registration, maintenance, and other incidental fees pertaining to the transfer of ownership of the aforesaid vehicles;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to donate and/or transfer without cost two (2) units of Prisoner Vans to the Quezon City Bureau of Jail Management and Penology and to turn over documents pertinent to its ownership.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution, together with the corresponding two (2) Deeds of Donation, be furnished to the Office of the City Mayor, the Quezon City Bureau of Jail Management and Penology, and the Quezon City General Services Department, for records, inventory, and future reference.
