A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, ON BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT AS DONOR, TO ENTER INTO A DEED OF DONATION WITH THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DISTRICT (QCPD) AS DONEE FOR THE DONATION OF VARIOUS PROTECTIVE GEARS AT NO COST AND TO EFFECT THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP THEREOF WITHOUT COST TO THE RECIPIENT

WHEREAS, Section 455(b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance;


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23 of the Local Government Code of 1991, the Local Chief Executive may, upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, negotiate for and secure financial grants or donations in kind in support of the delivery of basic services and facilities enumerated under Section 17 of the said Code;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 51(2) of Executive Order No. 292, otherwise known as the Administrative Code of 1987, contracts entered into by political subdivisions and by corporate agencies or instrumentalities of the government shall be approved by their respective governing boards or councils and executed by their respective executive heads;

WHEREAS, the donation of the following protective gears is deemed necessary to ensure the effective and efficient delivery of essential services to the constituents of Quezon City and to the general public:

WHEREAS, the Deed of Donation and Acceptance is made an integral part of this Resolution and a copy thereof is attached as Annex A;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Police District (QCPD) plays a vital role in maintaining peace and order, safeguarding the lives and properties of the citizenry, and ensuring public safety within the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the procurement and donation of protective gears such as soft ballistic panels, combat helmets, and tactical goggles are essential to enhance the safety and operational efficiency of police personnel, particularly during the conduct of anti-criminality operations, emergency response, and other law enforcement activities;


WHEREAS, it is imperative for the Quezon City Government to extend support to the QCPD by providing protective equipment that will reduce occupational hazards faced by its personnel in the line of duty;

WHEREAS, such donation is aligned with the policy of the State, as enshrined in Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 which mandates every local government unit to exercise powers essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, the grant of protective gears to the QCPD shall redound to the benefit of the constituents of Quezon City, as it will enable police officers to effectively perform their duties and responsibilities in ensuring public order, safety, and security.

NOW, THEREFORE,


