

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Sports Development Office was created by virtue of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2917, S-2020, otherwise known as the Quezon City Sports Code;



WHEREAS, the abovementioned vehicle will be used by the Quezon City Sports Development Office intended for monitoring and implementation of its projects and programs.


NOW, THEREFORE,
