RESOLUTION NO. SP- **10282**, S-2025

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE MILLION PESOS (PHP5,000,000.00) TO VARIOUS LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS IN THE PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL DUE TO THE ADVERSE IMPACT OF THE MAGNITUDE 7.4 EARTHQUAKE AND IN SUPPORT OF THEIR DISASTER RESPONSE, RECOVERY, AND REHABILITATION TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE ACCUMULATED LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT (LDRRM) SPECIAL TRUST FUND


WHEREAS, on October 10, 2025 at around 9:43 A.M., a magnitude 7.4 earthquake struck the Province of Davao Oriental, causing widespread damage to infrastructure, both public and private properties;

WHEREAS, based on the Provincial Davao Oriental Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (PDRRMO) Situational Report (Progress Report No.2) dated 12 October 2025 (12:00 N.N.), the earthquake resulted in at least three (3) fatalities and 294 injured individuals, affecting a total of 119,814 families which represents 20.30% of the total number of families in the province;

WHEREAS, the same report further indicated that the earthquake caused the displacement of 39,070 families (59,397 individuals) and the destruction of 3,972 houses;

WHEREAS, five (5) local government units (LGUs) in the province have declared a State of Calamity to wit:

WHEREAS, the aforementioned declarations prompted the Provincial Government of Davao Oriental to declare a province-wide State of Calamity through Provincial Resolution No. 18-152-10-2025;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, in the spirit of inter-LGU cooperation and humanitarian solidarity, has mobilized and deployed a total of fifteen (15) personnel from the Quezon City Government to conduct Rapid Damage Assessment and Need Analysis (RDANA);

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (QCDRRMC) issued Resolution No. 13, S. 2025, recommending to the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, the provision of a Five Million Peso (Php5,000,000.00) financial assistance to various local government units in the Province of Davao Oriental;

WHEREAS, recognizing the gravity of the disaster and the urgent need of assistance, the Quezon City Government deems it necessary to extend financial support to the affected LGUs in Davao Oriental to help alleviate the hardship of impacted communities and to aid in on-going relief, recovery, and rehabilitation efforts.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to extend financial assistance in the amount of Five Million Pesos (Php5,000,000.00) to various local government units in the Province of Davao Oriental due to the adverse impact of the magnitude 7.4 earthquake and in support of their disaster response, recovery, and rehabilitation to be charged against the accumulated Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (LDRRM) Special Trust Fund.
