

WHEREAS, the Michelin Guide, the world's most respected authority on culinary excellence, launched its inaugural Philippines 2026 Edition recognizing the Country's finest dining establishments across Manila, Cebu, and surrounding areas;

WHEREAS, a total of 108 establishments were recognized in the inaugural Guide, of which 25 Philippine restaurants were awarded the prestigious Bib Gourmand distinction for delivering exceptionally good food at moderate prices, while several others were included in the Michelin Selected list for their outstanding dining experience;

WHEREAS, seven (7) restaurants based in Quezon City were recognized in the Guide, bringing immense pride to the City by showcasing the richness, diversity, creativity, and world-class quality of its culinary heritage, namely:

- a. Morning Sun Eatery – located in Project 4, known for authentic Ilocano comfort food;
- b. Palm Grill – located in Tomas Morato Avenue, recognized for rich Southern Mindanao (Tausug) cuisine;
- c. Some Thai – located in Tomas Morato corner Scout Fuentebella, offering modern Thai dishes;
- d. Deo Gracias – located in Diliman, offering refined Spanish-Filipino fusion;
- e. Esmeralda Kitchen – located in Santa Mesa Heights, offering Filipino classics with a modern touch;
- f. Fong Wei Wu – located in Banawe Street, serving authentic Taiwanese cuisine; and
- g. Mōdan – located in Cubao, a contemporary Japanese-inspired restaurant;






