*WHEREAS, Alexandra "Alex" Eala, a 20-year-old Filipina tennis sensation and a proud native of Quezon City, has made history by ending the 2025 Women's Tennis Association (WTA) Tour ranked World No. 50 — the highest ranking ever achieved by a Filipina tennis player;*

*WHEREAS, Ms. Eala's remarkable ascent in the world rankings was fueled by a breakthrough season highlighted by her first WTA title at the Guadalajara Open in Mexico, a stunning debut in the US Open main draw, and significant victories over some of the world's top-ranked players, including World No. 2 Iga Swiatek, World No. 5 Madison Keys, and World No. 15 Clara Tauson;*

*WHEREAS, Ms. Eala's historic achievements have placed the Philippines on the global tennis map, as she became the first Filipina to qualify for the main draws of the US Open, French Open, and Wimbledon, with the Australian Open set to complete her participation in all four (4) Grand Slam events by 2026;*


NOW, THEREFORE,


