A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION TWO HUNDRED NINETY-THREE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY PESOS (PHP2,293,760.00) TO THE QUEZON CITY PERFORMING ARTS DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION, INC. (QCPADFI) TO COVER THE EXPENSES FOR THE UPCOMING 12<sup>TH</sup> CHEERLEADING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS (CWC) TO BE HELD ON DECEMBER 10 TO 14, 2025 AT THE TAKASAKI ARENA, JAPAN




WHEREAS, the QCPADFI aims to be recognized globally in the field of performing arts and their participation in this year's championship will continue to present the artistry, dedication, and excellence in the performing arts of their scholars. Likewise, this international competition is a prestigious platform for them to showcase their skills alongside top teams from around the world;

WHEREAS, the QCPADFI represented the Country in the 2015 Cheerleading World Championships in Germany, earned silver medals, and was a great source of pride for the Philippines. This is a testament of our dance scholars' outstanding talent and discipline. It is in this light that our dance scholars are being called again to represent the Country on the international stage;

WHEREAS, the Asian Federation of Cheerleading has formally invited the QCPADFI to participate as the official Philippine entry to the upcoming 12<sup>th</sup> Cheerleading World Championships (CWC) to be held on December 10 to 14, 2025 at the Takasaki Arena, Japan;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government recognizes and believes that joining international competitions and performing with other talented groups from other Countries will help the QCPADFI achieve their goal to be a globally-recognized performing arts institution, empowering the City's youth who are proud of their identity and heritage;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is willing to support the QCPADFI by extending financial assistance in the amount of Two Million Two Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Pesos (Php2,293,760.00) to the QCPADFI to cover the expenses for the upcoming 12<sup>th</sup> CWC;



WHEREAS, Section 36 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that a local government unit may, through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the Sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise, to such people's and non-governmental organizations for economic, socially-oriented, environmental, or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction.


NOW, THEREFORE,
