*WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2219, S-2013, otherwise known as the Quezon City Economic Development Incentives Code of 2013, as amended by Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3296, S-2024, entitled: "An Ordinance Revising Ordinance No. SP-2219, S-2013, Otherwise Known As The 'Quezon City Economic Development Incentives Code of 2013,' By Repealing Book III and Book IV of the Ordinance, Updating the Incentives Provided to Medium and Large Enterprises, and Doing Away with the Categorization of Pioneer and Non-Pioneer Enterprises," establishing a policy framework to encourage the entry, expansion, diversification, and modernization of medium and large enterprises through the provision of incentive packages that support the City's socio-economic development goals and promote domestic and foreign investments;*



WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3301, S-2024, establishing the Quezon City Local Economic Development and Investment Promotions Office and strengthening the structure and composition of the Quezon City Economic Development and Investment Board (QC-EDIB), further amended Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2219, S-2013;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4 of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3301, S-2024, the QC-EDIB shall update and approve every three (3) years the Investment Priorities Plan (IPP) and Economic Development and Investment Plan (EDIP) in alignment with the City's Comprehensive Land Use Plan and the Comprehensive Development Plan;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government recognizes the strategic importance of collaboration with the private sector in the pursuit of its goals;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government further recognizes that such partnership can be cultivated by creating conditions conducive to the growth and competitiveness of this sector;

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2023, the QC-EDIB approved the proposed Investment Priorities Plan, identifying the City's priority sectors for incentives;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Economic Development and Investment Plan (EDIP) for the years 2025-2028 prioritizes investments in Circular and Sustainable Infrastructure, Creative Economy, Innovation and Technology, and Inclusive Economy;

WHEREAS, the EDIP is aligned with the three (3) main thrusts of the economic development sector under the 14-Point Agenda of the present administration namely: make Quezon City the preferred destination for businesses, create new jobs across more businesses, and develop growth hubs;

WHEREAS, the three (3) main thrusts of the economic development sector which support the development of new growth hubs will provide an avenue for workforce development, whilst fostering environment protection, food sustainability, education and health, and industry linkages.

NOW, THEREFORE,



RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of the Quezon City Economic Development and Investment Plan for the years 2025-2028 shall form an integral part of this Resolution.


