

WHEREAS, Quezon City Council has adopted Resolution No. SP-9182, S-2023, granting authority to the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a memorandum of agreement with various accredited funeral homes service providers for the implementation of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2865, S-2019, otherwise known as "Quezon City Libreng-Palibing Ordinance of 2019";

WHEREAS, the said Ordinance provides free decent funeral services to qualified indigent residents through guarantee letters in partnership with accredited funeral homes service providers within Quezon City;

WHEREAS, to effectively implement the said Ordinance, it is necessary for the Quezon City Government to partner with duly-accredited funeral service providers that can deliver the required services promptly, adequately, and in accordance with established standards;

WHEREAS, the accredited funeral homes service providers that have pledged to extend their services in support of the City's Libreng Palibing Program, are as follows:

WHEREAS, the decent funeral services standard cost shall not exceed Twenty-Five Thousand Pesos (Php25,000.00) in the form of a guarantee letter per qualified beneficiary;

WHEREAS, the Social Services Development Department (SSDD) shall be responsible for the proper implementation of the Quezon City Libreng-Palibing Ordinance of 2019 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations;

WHEREAS, Section 22(c) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that “no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the sanggunian concerned.”


NOW, THEREFORE,


