

WHEREAS, Section 19, Article XIV of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines provides that the "State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions to foster self-discipline, teamwork and excellence for the development of healthy and alert citizenry";

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 6847, otherwise known as the Philippine Sports Commission Act, created and established the Philippine Sports Commission to serve as the sole policy-making and coordinating body of all amateur sports development programs and institutions in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government has requested for financial support for the conduct of its continuing sports development program in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Sports Commission, in line with its mandate under Republic Act No. 6847 to spearhead the sports promotion and development programs of the Country, is committed to help ensure and favorably consider and approve the requested financial assistance for the conduct of the sports development program;

WHEREAS, there is a need to authorize the Honorable City Mayor to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement with the Philippine Sports Commission as one of the requirements for the grant of financial assistance in the amount of Five Million Pesos (Php5,000,000.00) for the conduct of the sports development program;


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455(b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement with the Philippine Sports Commission for the conduct of the Sports Development Program in Quezon City.


