WHEREAS, on December 13, 2025, the Iglesia Ni Cristo (Church of Christ) conducted its Aid for Humanity (Lingap sa Mamamayan) activity in Songkhla, Thailand, in response to massive flooding caused by prolonged and heavy rains that displaced families and severely affected local communities;

WHEREAS, through the distribution of care packages containing primary relief goods, the Iglesia Ni Cristo provided timely and much-needed assistance to flood victims, demonstrating compassion, solidarity, and concern for humanity beyond national borders;

NOW, THEREFORE,




