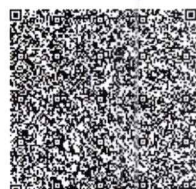

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be forwarded to all offices concerned.


