A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF POT OF GOLD INTERNET GAMING, INC., FOR THE OPERATION OF AN ELECTRONIC GAMES (E-GAMES) ESTABLISHMENT LOCATED AT UNIT 2, CITY SQUARE BUILDING, N.S. AMORANTO CORNER CORDILLERA STREET, BARANGAY MAHARLIKA, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR)

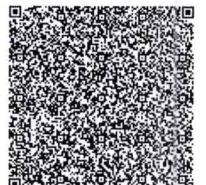

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to continue its business operations, there is a need to renew its Special Permit pursuant to an existing City ordinance;

WHEREAS, the operation of an Electronic Games (E-Games) establishment is regulated and licensed by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR);

WHEREAS, the aforementioned business activity will provide employment and additional revenue to the Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended, and Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, authorize the City Council to grant or renew a Special Permit to business activities of the same nature.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of Pot of Gold Internet Gaming, Inc., for the operation of an Electronic Games (E-Games) establishment located at No. Unit 2, City Square Building, N.S. Amoranto corner Cordillera Street, Barangay Maharlika, District I, Quezon City, subject to the Rules and Regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

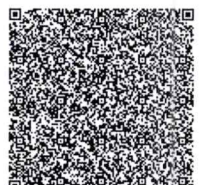
RESOLVED FURTHER, that the authority to operate an E-Games establishment granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. the holding of E-Games shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;
2. the operation of an E-Games establishment shall not include playing of games not related to or other than E-Games;
3. the operation is enjoined to prohibit from playing the abovementioned games in their gaming site individuals below twenty-one (21) years of age or students of any school, college or university;
4. Pot of Gold Internet Gaming, Inc. shall remit a license fee of three percent (3%) of the gross receipt of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasurer's Office during the lifetime of this Resolution, in accordance with Section 25, Article III of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended;
5. this Resolution is non-assignable, non-transferable, and site-address specific; and


6. the establishment shall not be a nuisance to public safety and order.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that this renewal of a Special Permit to operate an E-Games establishment shall be valid for a period of three (3) years from the approval of this Resolution and may be renewed by the City Council.
