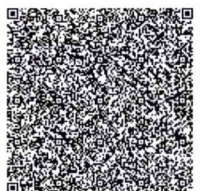

WHEREAS, the Quezon City University (QCU) dominated the VEX U Robotics Competition National Championship in the Philippines held last January 29 to 30, 2026 with two (2) competing teams:

- a. Team Alpha – emerged as the Tournament Champion with an 8-0 record; and
- b. Team Beta – finished as Tournament Runner-Up and earned the Best Design Award

WHEREAS, the QCU Robotics Team garnered all major awards, namely the Excellence Award, Best Design Award, Robot Skills Challenge Champion, and Tournament Champion;

WHEREAS, following their national performance, the QCU Robotics Team is currently ranked 17th out of 160 teams worldwide in the VEX World Skills Standings, and will proudly represent the Philippines at the VEX Robotics World Championship in St. Louis, Missouri, USA to be held on April 21 to 30, 2026;

WHEREAS, this serves as an inspiration to the youth of Quezon City to pursue their goals through perseverance, dedication, and excellence.

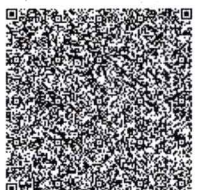
NOW, THEREFORE,




