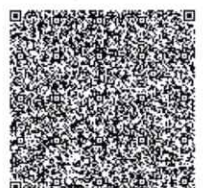

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Climate Change and Environmental Sustainability Department (CCESD) has launched the “Trash to Cashback: Green to Grain” Program, which incentivizes recycling and proper segregation of single-use plastics and other recyclables through an environmental points system;

*WHEREAS, strengthened information dissemination and coordinated local promotion can significantly increase participation, improve waste diversion rates, and contribute to the City's sustainability goals.*

*BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to express, as it does hereby express, full support for the "Trash to Cashback: Green to Grain" Program of the Quezon City Climate Change and Environmental Sustainability Department and encouraging all Barangays and Sangguniang Kabataan to strengthen information dissemination and community participation.*

*RESOLVED FURTHER, that all Barangays in Quezon City are hereby strongly encouraged to conduct localized information campaigns through barangay assemblies, social media platforms, posters, public announcements, and other appropriate means to promote active participation in the program.*

*RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that Barangays are encouraged to designate focal persons or eco-volunteers to assist in information dissemination and community mobilization efforts.*

*RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that all Sangguniang Kabataan are encouraged to initiate youth-led awareness drives, volunteer mobilization activities, and digital campaigns to increase participation among young residents.*


