A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO DONATE TEN (10) COMPOSTING BINS TO BARANGAY SAN BARTOLOME, DISTRICT V, QUEZON CITY, TO BE UTILIZED FOR ORGANIC WASTE COMPOSTING FOR BARANGAY URBAN FARMING PURPOSES

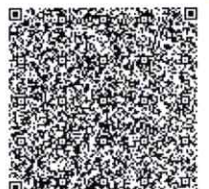
WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is in possession of ten (10) composting bins which were procured through Public Bidding in the amount of two thousand nine hundred ninety pesos (Php2,990.00) per unit;

WHEREAS, said pieces of equipment have been duly recorded in the property inventory of the Quezon City Government and certified by the proper office as available for donation in accordance with existing accounting, auditing, and property regulations;

WHEREAS, the procurement of said pieces of equipment was undertaken in support of the City's Circular Economy Program and to strengthen organic waste composting initiatives;

WHEREAS, this initiative is consistent with the priority programs under the City's Enhanced Local Climate Change Action Plan 2021-2050, where Ecosystem and Environmental Sustainability is one of its pillars;

WHEREAS, the composting bins have the following specifications:

Features: Plastic container with faucet and screen
Capacity: 20 liters
Height: 360 mm
Diameter: 300 mm
Thickness: 2 mm
Weight: 1,025 g
Color: White

WHEREAS, the composting bins are intended to be distributed to Barangay San Bartolome for utilization in its barangay urban farming and organic waste diversion initiatives;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government shall monitor the utilization of the donated pieces of equipment for purposes of documenting the volume of organic waste diverted and ensuring that the same are used strictly for public purposes;

WHEREAS, Barangay San Bartolome shall execute an Acceptance and Undertaking and shall assume full responsibility for the custody, maintenance, proper utilization, and safekeeping of the donated equipment;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455(b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to donate ten (10) composting bins to Barangay San Bartolome, District V, Quezon City, to be utilized for Organic Waste Composting for Barangay Urban Farming purposes.
