A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO DONATE TWENTY (20) BIODIGESTER SYSTEMS TO SELECTED BARANGAYS IN QUEZON CITY, TO BE UTILIZED FOR ORGANIC WASTE COMPOSTING AND BARANGAY URBAN FARMING INITIATIVES

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is in possession of twenty (20) Biodigester Systems which were procured by the City Government through public bidding in the amount of Two Hundred Forty-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php249,750.00) per unit;

WHEREAS, the total acquisition of the said Biodigester Systems represents a significant public investment intended to strengthen the City's circular economy initiatives, particularly in organic waste diversion and renewable energy generation;

WHEREAS, the said Biodigester Systems were procured in support of the City's Circular Economy Program and in furtherance of the priority programs under the Enhanced Local Climate Change Action Plan 2021-2050, where Ecosystem and Environmental Sustainability is one of its key pillars;

WHEREAS, each Biodigester System consists of a 1,200-liter inflatable biogas digester capable of digesting biodegradable waste and producing cooking gas, complete with gas stove and safety components;

WHEREAS, the subject Biodigester Systems have been duly recorded in the property inventory of the Quezon City Government and certified by the proper office as available for donation in accordance with existing accounting, auditing, and property regulations;

WHEREAS, the biodigester systems shall be distributed to the following barangays:

- District I: Bahay Toro, Project 6, and San Antonio
- District II: Batasan Hills, Commonwealth, Holy Spirit, and Payatas
- District III: Matandang Balara, Silangan, Tagumpay, and West Kamias
- District IV: Central – Circle and Doña Imelda
- District V: Sta. Monica
- District VI: Apolonio Samson, Culiati, Pasong Tamo, Sangandaan, and Tandang Sora – Sunnyville Farm Tandang Sora

WHEREAS, the concerned Barangays have expressed their willingness to utilize the donated equipment exclusively for organic waste composting and urban farming initiatives and to assume full responsibility for their custody and maintenance;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455(b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to donate twenty (20) Biodigester Systems to selected Barangays in Quezon City, to be utilized for organic waste composting and barangay urban farm initiatives.


