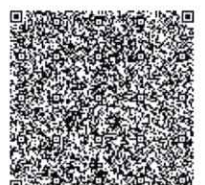

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive may, upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, negotiate for and secure financial grants or donations in kind in support of the delivery of basic services and facilities, as provided under Section 17 of the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 51(2) of Executive Order No. 292, otherwise known as the Administrative Code of 1987, contracts entered into by political subdivisions and by corporate agencies or instrumentalities of the government shall be approved by their respective governing boards or councils and executed by their respective executive heads;

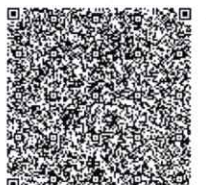
