WHEREAS, the inclusive and orderly observance of religious and cultural celebrations promotes harmony, public safety, and respect for diversity among QCitizens;

WHEREAS, barangays and local government offices play a key role in facilitating peaceful, organized, and inclusive community celebrations, while ensuring public order, accessibility, and respect for different beliefs and practices;

WHEREAS, coordination among religious groups, barangays, and concerned City offices helps ensure that celebrations are conducted in a manner that is safe, respectful, and considerate of the broader community;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government recognizes the importance of supporting religious and cultural celebrations in a way that upholds freedom of religion and cultural expression while promoting inclusivity and mutual respect.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to encourage, as it does hereby encourage, the inclusive, orderly, and respectful observance of religious and cultural celebrations in Quezon City.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that barangays be encouraged to coordinate with religious and cultural organizations in planning and conducting celebrations that are inclusive, accessible, and mindful of public order and community welfare.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that concerned City offices be encouraged to provide guidance and support, as appropriate, to ensure the safe, orderly, and peaceful conduct of religious and cultural activities, subject to existing policies and regulations.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that schools, youth organizations, and community groups be encouraged to promote awareness and appreciation of religious and cultural diversity through participation in inclusive celebrations and related educational activities.


